

UNIT 3 OUTCOME 1 (SAC 1) PRACTICE

TASK: Participate in a 4-5 minute informal discussion using information from different sources to explain and justify an opinion.

Specific Task: You meet a Deaf lady, Kim, in a Deaf Club. She has just moved to Australia from Ireland and wants to know what technologies are available for Deaf people in Australia, and how Deaf people feel about them.
